One Day Seminar on Value Education

The Department of History conducted one-day seminar on Value Education on 30 January, 2020. Value education has been considered as one of the most important aspects of human life since ancient ages. Though it is abstract term it is about the educational process that instils moral standards to create more civil and democratic societies. The resource persons for this seminar were Dr. M. K. Fasale, Principal of Abasaheb Kakade College, Bodhegaon, Pathardi and Dr. Ashok Kanade, Member of Maharashtra Itihas Parishad.

The inaugural session was conducted between 10.30 to 11.30 am under the auspices of Dr. Fasale and Dr. Kanade. On this occasion the head of Department of History Dr.K.L. Giramkar explained the idea of the seminar on Value Education. He extensively spoke on the need of Value Education to the under graduate and post graduate students.

In the first session Dr. M. K. Fasale talked about value education are principles, fundamental convictions, and ideals, standards of life which act as general guide to behaviour or as a reference point in decision making. Values are beliefs about what is right and what is wrong and what is important in life. Value literally means something that has a price, precious, dear and worthwhile, one is ready to sacrifice for. • It is a set of principles which guide the standard of behaviour. Values are desirable and held in esteem. They give strength to a person's character by occupying a central place in his life. It reflects ones attitudes, choices, decisions, judgments, relationships, dreams and vision. • The guiding principle of life which are conducive to all value development. It is like the rails which keep the train on track. Without values, life will be chaotic. • Values are virtues, ideals and qualities on which actions and beliefs are based. Values are guiding principles that shape our world outlook, attitudes and conduct. The moral values



present a true perspective of the development of any society or nation. They tell us to what extent a society or nation has developed itself.

In the second session Dr. Ashok Kanade told that value education means teaching and learning of ideals. The aim is for students to understand moral values and show their good behaviour and attitude towards society.

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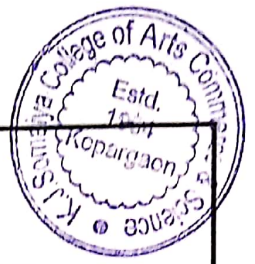

Inaugural Speech by Hon. Principal Dr. B. S. Yadav

Hon. Prof. Dr. Sanjay Dhole, Department of Physics, S.P.P. University, Pune and Hon. Principal Dr. B. S. Yadav inaugurated this conference. Dr. B. B. Bhosale, Incharge, Faculty of Science opened the session with welcome address to chief guest. Principal, Dr. B. S. Yadav clarified the approach and his views behind conducting this Workshop.

In **Session-I Dr. Sanjay Dhole** focused on the basic concepts of Intellectual Property Rights. “Intellectual property” are type of property that results from creation of the human mind, the intellect. Intellectual property management starts with the germ of an idea. IP by itself neither helps nor hinders development necessarily. It is how laws, policies and practices are designed and used in different countries that determine whether IP is effective for development purposes. In his presentation on intellectual property he has placed itself on a pedestal in the context of economic growth and is becoming increasingly important. Intellectual Property (IP) is the fuel that powers the engine of prosperity, fostering invention and innovation. The increasing significance of intangible assets in the global economy is

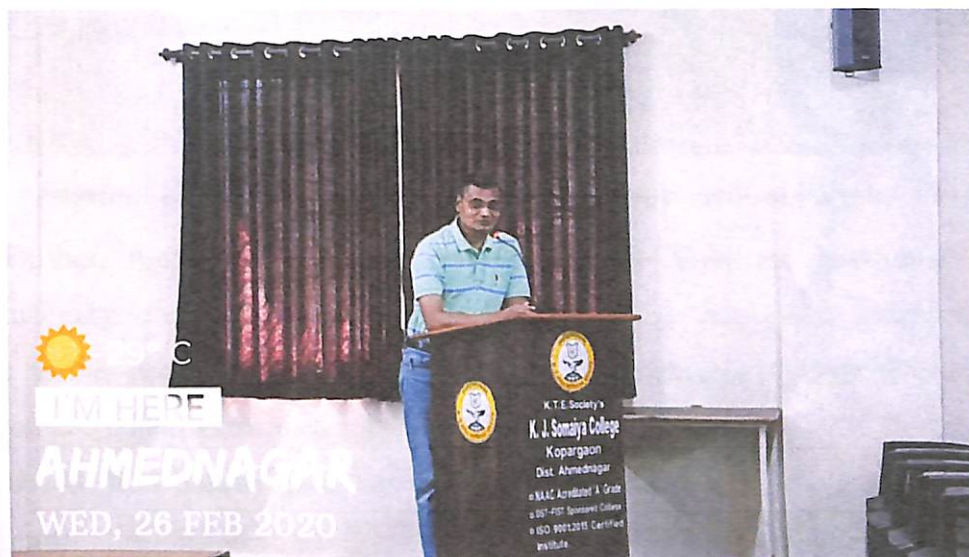
forcing business organizations to actively manage their IP as a key driver for building and sustaining their competitive advantage and achieving superior performance.



Session: I- Speaker; Dr. Sanjay Dhole, Department of Physics, S.P.P. University, Pune

IP has gained center stage and has attained more focus, more attention and is a subject matter of discussion between government, institutions, industries under various regimes and protocol that are put in place to ensure that the world in which we live, where knowledge and innovation are the engines of development and growth. In that world, those who have the creative minds and ability should feel assured that not only their efforts have been duly recognized but it is secured in a specified manner.

It is also important to promote intellectual property licensing practices, particularly, with a view to foster creativity, innovation and the transfer and dissemination of technology to developing countries and least developed countries. There has to be both free transfer of technology which will address the challenge of climate change and also transfer of recourses to poor countries.

Further, there are intellectual assets and then there are intellectual properties- intellectual properties are where a government gives you an authority in return of an annuity, just like normal property; but before an IP there is something called the intellectual assets, where you keep them as trade secrets.

Dr. B. B. Bhosale spoke on IPRs play a crucial role as the legal vehicle through which either the transfer of knowledge or the contractual relationship is affected.

Alternatively, knowledge may be exploited in-house, in which case the role of IPRs is to block imitating competition. Commercialization can be defined as the process of turning an invention or creation into a commercially viable product, service or process. Commercialization may require additional R&D, product developments, clinical trials or development of techniques to scale-up production prior to taking the results of research to market. This is important because not all inventors or creators wish or have the resources, skill and appetite for risk to commercialize their own inventions or creations.

In this workshop **70 students and 25 faculty members** participated. The workshop gave very good learning experience to all the participants and it was ended the hope that there would be positive approach regarding Intellectual Property Right.





Workshop was very beneficiary for students. Students actively ask their query and get the answers about python language.


