(Held on 20 April 2022, Time: 10 AM)

One day webinar on "Introduction to Astrophysics and Career opportunities in Astrophysics" was organized by students mentoring program, Department of Physics and IQAC on Wednesday 20th April 2022. For this webinar Dr. Vikram Khaire who is working as DST-INSPIRE faculty at Indian Institute of space science and technology, Thiruvanthapuram kerala was invited as resource person. Program started with introductory speech of Prof. N. S. Pote. In the Introductory speech Prof. N. S. Pote shares information of students mentoring cell. He also explained Dr. Vikram Khaire is a renowned scientist working in Astrophysics. Later Dr. V. C. Thanage gives IQAC address to audience. In his address Dr. Thanage shares that we all are proud of Dr. Vikram khaire that He is giving marvelous contribution in research. After IQAC address Prof Dr. B. B. Bhosale address the audience, Dr. Bhosale told audience that after the covid-19 pandemic it was need of hour to organize such talk. He also told students to be attentive during program. Later on Dr. S. L. Aragade gives introduction of resource person. After that Dr. Vikram Khaire started his talk. Dr. Vikram Khaire divided his talk into two parts, in first part he gives "Introduction of Astrophysics" and in later half he explained "Career opportunities in Astrophysics". In Introduction to Astrophysics talk Dr. Khaire started with our solar system. The planetary scales he explained was extraordinary, all the audience stunned by hearing such big numbers and calculations. One thing worthy to note here that Dr. Khaire told that it will took around 42000 years to reach our neighbor planet alpha century !. If we divide number of stars in universe by world population each one will get billions of stars that our natural lives will not be enough to count them. Dr. Khaire then explained briefly about our star sun, size of our sun is such big that around 1000 earths will fit into sun. Later on he explained about our neighbor planets, Milky Way galaxy, he told audience that some galaxies are so distant that light we observing today was emitted few thousands of years ago by these galaxies so basically we are watching at past. Then Dr. Khaire explained types of telescopes that used for sky observation in that He specially mention Hubble space telescope which is situated in space for observation. Then Dr. Khaire explained in detail about life cycle of stars, stars born in nebula and die as black hole of red giant. Later on He explained about solar system elements using periodic table. He told that Helium was discovered by taking spectral observations of sun. Dr. Vikram khaire ended his talk by showing his favorite picture that taken by Voyages satellite. The picture was the just one white dot on screen and that was our earth in this vast universe he explained that we are merely a tiny speck in this vast universe. In the later half Dr. Khaire explained about the Career opportunities in Astrophysics, He told that doing research,

teaching, software developer, data analyst etc. are bright career option. He also explained about various agencies that provide financial support to carry out research in India as well as abroad.
